Dear Mr. Crovella:

This follows our recent telephone conversations concerning the window washing equipment on the Sunroad Spectrum 12 building. As we discussed, when the equipment is upright, it adds approximately 17 feet to the height of the building. As the building currently exists, if the window washing equipment is upright, the height of the building is 184.58 AGL or 600.58 MSI

Given the extreme sensitivity of the structure's height, the Department of Transportation requests a statement in writing concerning the FAA's position regarding the window washing equipment. This includes a statement as to whether the FAA will impose any conditions, including, but not limited to, day use only, VFR weather only, or lighted if allowed to remain upright during the night.
